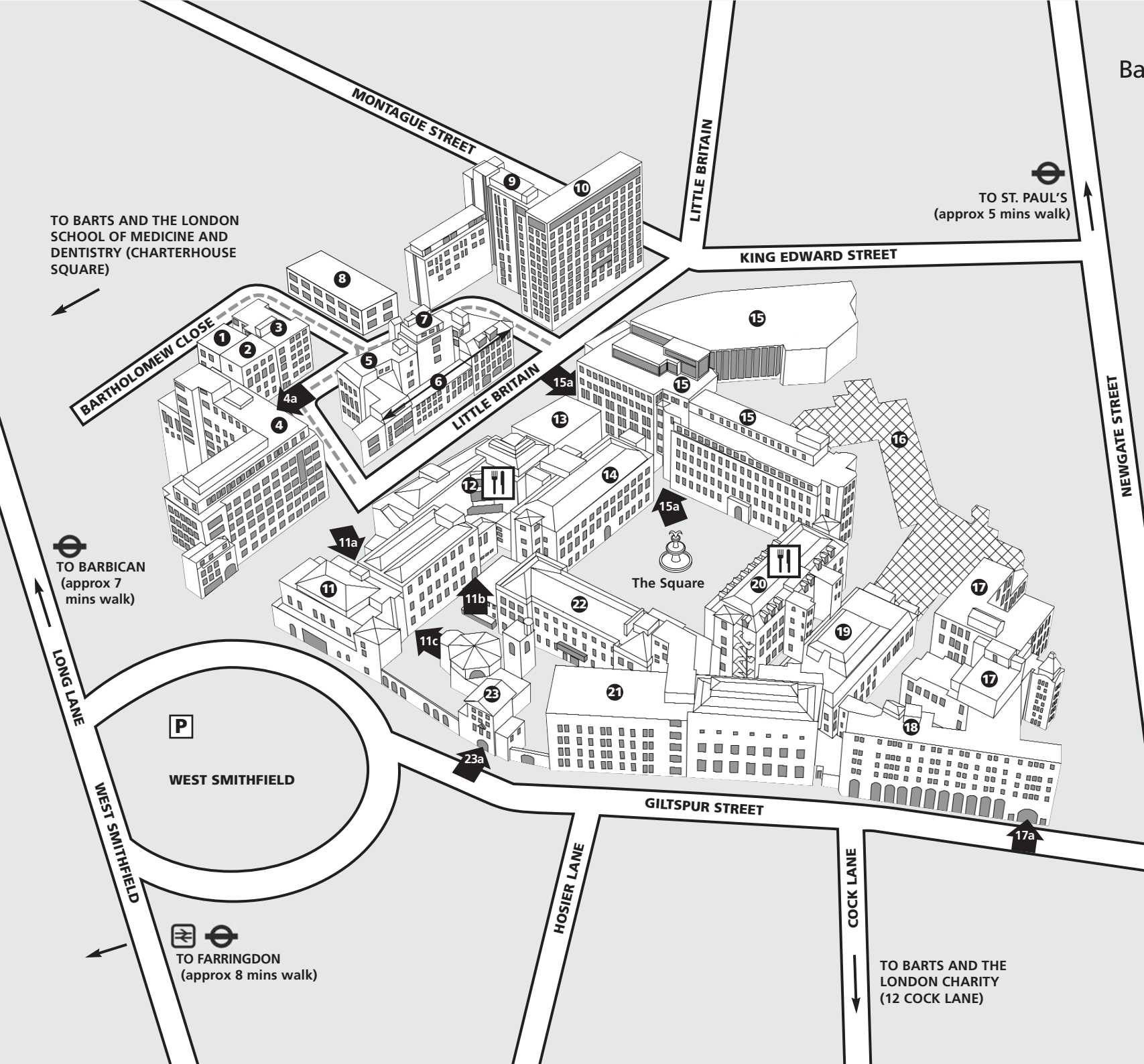

## Transforming your hospital

Work is underway to redevelop Barts as a Cancer and Cardiac Centre of Excellence, a project that will create 21<sup>st</sup> century facilities to complement our high quality clinical services.

Our priority is to ensure patient safety while this much-needed transformation takes place, but some disruption and noise is inevitable. We are sorry about this – please bear with us. If you are concerned about the effect of the building work on your care while you are in hospital, please tell a member of staff.

The map overleaf shows you which area is affected by the construction work – signs at the hospital will also help you find your way around.

## Getting to Barts

If at all possible, please use public transport to come into hospital, or ask someone to drop you off:

### **Tube:**

The nearest underground stations are Barbican, Farringdon and St Paul's. Blackfriars underground station is also nearby, but is closed until late 2011. Barbican and Farringdon are served by Hammersmith and City line, Metropolitan line and the Circle line. St Paul's is served by the Central line.

### **Rail:**

Blackfriars, City Thameslink and Liverpool Street are the nearest National Rail stations.

### **Buses:**

The following buses stop outside or close to Barts: numbers 4, 8, 25, 56, 172 and 242.

### **Drop-off point for taxis and cars:**

Patients can be dropped off in the Square, which can be accessed via Henry VIII Gate on Giltspur Street.

### **Parking:**

There is no public parking at the hospital itself, but there is metered parking in surrounding streets and an NCP car park in West Smithfield.
